2024 TRASH, RECYCLING & BULK PICK UP CALENDAR



The trash schedule for January through December 2024 is available on the town website. Printed copies of the schedule are available at Town Hall and the North Beach Post Office. Remember to place trash cans curbside the night before the collection date. Trash must be bagged and placed in a trash can with a lid. Bulk trash pickup is the third Friday of each month, by appointment only. Call Town Hall by the Tuesday prior to the pickup date to schedule an appointment for your bulk trash pickup.

RECYCLING IN NORTH BEACH



Residents are encouraged to consult the Residential Recycling Guide for information on acceptable items for recycling pickup. All items may be commingled and placed in a container, clearly labeled as "recycling." If you are new to recycling, begin with clean and empty plastic jugs, bottles, trays, containers, etc. Be cautious of single-use plastics like straws, cutlery, and bags. Remember: when in doubt, throw it out! For additional details on recycling, visit the Residents tab on the town website. ARE YOU SEEING PURPLE STREETLIGHTS?



If you have noticed streetlights glowing a purple hue, BGE wants to know! According to BGE, the purple lights are caused by a manufacturer's defect and should be replaced. Help identify the location of the purple lights by reporting them using BGE's online streetlight repair map at <https://bge.streetlightoutages.com/public/default.html>. Once reported, BGE crews will work to replace the defective streetlights.

WATER & SEWER BILLING



Quarterly water and sewer bills will be sent out next week. Residents have the flexibility of paying quarterly, monthly, bi-weekly or weekly. ELECTRICITY OUTAGE MAP



BGE's online interactive outage map provides customers with helpful information during storm and power outages. BGE's Outage Map is available at <http://www.BGE.com/outages> or through the company's Mobile App, which gives customers the ability to report power outages, check on the status of outages, and manage the type of alerts they would like to receive. The Outage Map updates every ten minutes which makes the data considerably accurate at any given time.

SEWER INSPECTION PROJECT



A project to inspect all sewer lines in town is underway. Weather permitting, Strohecker, Inc. will be working each week from Monday through Thursday for approximately two months. The inspection process involves the use of a camera, running from one manhole to the next (approximately 350 feet), and repeating this procedure until the entire town is covered. For the duration of this project, the Department of Public Works will accompany the Strohecker team, which will be operating from a large box truck displaying the company name.
